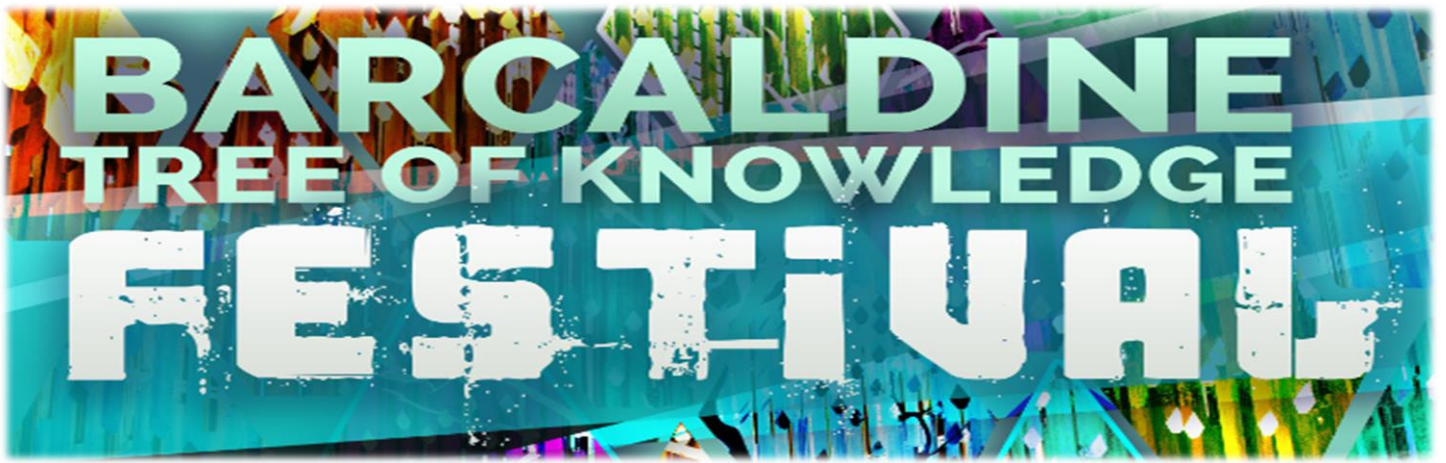
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OUTBACK TALENT QUEST RULES

1. The Outback Talent Quest is open to all amateur entertainers. Professionals (performers whose talent is a principle source of income) are not permitted to enter.
2. The show is open to any age with three categories, primary (12 years and under), secondary (13 years to 17 years) and open (18 years and over).
3. The performance needs to be live on Friday 3 May 2019 at the Tree of Knowledge Precinct.
4. All contestants under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian complete the registration forms and agree to the terms and conditions. To participate in the open category contestants must be at least 18 years of age.
5. Talents may include (but not limited to) singing, dancing, instrumental music, skits, magic, comedy, martial arts, juggling. However, no lip-synching.
6. No sharp instruments, including swords, knives, axes, may be used in any acts and no hazardous liquids may be used, including naked flames.
7. Everyone must return a completed and signed Outback Talent Quest entry form in order to enter.
8. Participants who are part of a group act should submit their entry forms together.
9. Recommended length is 3 minutes; acts must be no more than 8 minutes.
10. Maximum number of participants in an act is 8.
11. Absolutely no profanity or insensitive subject matter will be permitted.
12. Costumes must be appropriate for all age groups. This is a community event.
13. Acts are responsible for their own props and costumes.
14. The Barcaldine Tree of Knowledge Committee and the Barcaldine Regional Council nor any individual member of the organising committee accept any responsibility for copyright issues pertaining to any act. It is the responsibility of the participant to seek permission for copyright from the copyright owner if required.
15. If your act requires recorded accompanying music, the music must be provided to the Barcaldine Tree of Knowledge Festival Committee via the Barcaldine Administration Office, 71 Ash Street, Barcaldine QLD 4725 by Thursday 2 May 2019. The CD or USB must be labelled with your name and song name. It is the participant's responsibility to retrieve the accompanying music back after the show.
16. All technical requirements must be listed on the entry form, failure to do so may result in the requirements being unavailable on the day.
17. Any equipment used, which belongs to the organisers, must be treated with respect and handled responsibly.
18. The Barcaldine Tree of Knowledge Committee and the Barcaldine Regional Council accept no responsibility for loss or damage to any property belonging to anyone involved in the competition.
19. In all cases, decisions of the judges are final and will not be open to discussion.
20. Recipients of first, second and third places for the primary and secondary categories will automatically be entered into the open category and can be the recipient of the open prizes. This will be based on the judges' points. Only one performance will be required.
21. There will be prizes given for first, second and third places in the three categories.
Primary prizes are: Third place \$50.00, second place \$100.00, first place \$200.00.
Secondary prizes are: Third place \$100.00, second place \$150.00, first place \$300.00.
Open prizes are: Third place \$400.00, second place \$750.00, first place \$2,000.00.
